  - o The athletes got to know each other, and felt more confidence at Westerns and Nationals competing with their peers.
  - Financial
    - Money spent on high level coaches was well worth the expense
    - The biggest cost is for the travel expenses for these coaches.
  - o Income was \$35,000
    - The cost of camp includes meals and lodging for the athletes.
    - Costs include the bus, food, lodging and Donna's stipend.
  - o This year the cost will be \$310 per athlete, 125 athletes (10 per squad).
